



## Buckeye Girls State Dress Code

Your pride in yourself as well as your role as a representative of our organization is reflected in your appearance and the image you create. We feel our Girls State image is important and require that our attendees maintain standards of dress and appearance appropriate to the organization as a whole and your individual position responsibilities. Dress, grooming, personal cleanliness, and professional behavior standards contribute to the professional image we present to those around us. Therefore, while performing duties of Girls State, attendees are expected to dress in attire appropriate to the Girls State environment and to behave in a professional and businesslike manner at all times to best represent our organization.

The following outline is meant to be a guideline for what is and is not considered appropriate attire for attendees of Buckeye Girls State.

Cover ups, camisoles, or undershirts must be worn to cover cleavage. Short dresses or skirts are not permitted at any time. Low open backs are not permitted unless paired with an undershirt or cover-up.

No mid-drifts are allowed at any time.

Flip flops are NOT permitted at special events, during government functioning and at most daily functions.



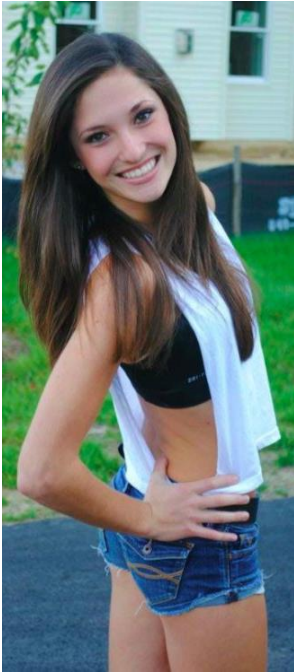
# NOT Appropriate
