Junior Cadet Week

Each year, select high school students interested in learning about law enforcement have the opportunity to apply for Junior Cadet Week – an intense, five-day training course at the Ohio State Highway Patrol Academy. See the OSHP representative that will have more information.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol provides the training facilities, staff and curriculum while the Ohio State Highway Patrol Auxiliary covers the cost of food and housing for each cadet plus program materials.

Junior Cadet Week is a joint program of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Ohio American Legion, Buckeye Boys State, **Ohio American Legion Auxiliary, Buckeye Girls State** and the Ohio State Highway Patrol Auxiliary. Junior Cadet Week is available to young men and women attending American Legion Buckeye Boys State and **Buckeye Girls State** in the current year and to the children of Ohio State Highway Patrol employees who will be seniors in the upcoming school year.
